



CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2020 GEOGRAPHE

With roots deeply planted in Harvey, the orchards and dairies of our family's farming history are now the backdrop to picturesque rows of vines at Harvey River Estate. It was in 1928 on the banks of the Harvey River that the first seeds were sown. Almost 100-years and three generations later our family's love of the land and region is as fervent as ever.

The wines are delectable and bright shining examples of the Geographe Wine Region. The vivid open slopes of vines are a chorus of alternative varieties and classics that sing the arias of our Italian heritage. Winemaker Stuart Pierce is a purist, and takes a minimal intervention approach to winemaking. Dedicated to creating wines of place, people and vintage.

TASTING NOTES

Youthful deep red core to the rim. Spiced mulberries and cassis upfront with subtle vanilla notes. Dry, soft elegant wine that carries considerable fruit weight of red berries with spicy notes through to the end.

WINEMAKING

Selection of seasoned French hogsheads for 14 months. Recommended to decant prior to serving.

VITICULTURE NOTES

A great vintage for Harvey reds, this Cabernet was harvested during the cool of night at optimum ripeness in a warm summer. The wine is deep coloured with great intensity, a small portion of Shiraz was blended in to lift the tannin profile and structure.
